•Champagne Bollinger has announced the latest vintage of La Grande Année, the house's prestige cuvée. The wine, a 2014 vintage Champagne, is made from 61% Pinot Noir and 39% Chardonnay, sourced from 19 different crus, with 79% Grand Crus and 21% Premier. The wine carries a suggested price of \$190 a bottle and is now available in the U.S. In addition to releasing the latest vintage, Champagne Bollinger has partnered with chefs Gabriel Kreuther in the U.S., Christopher Coutanceau in France, Eric Kragh Vidgaard in Denmark, Fabrizio Mellino in Italy, and Viki Geunes in Belgium to create special pairing menus to go with La Grande Année. Bollinger is imported by Vintus in the U.S.
